Chrysanthemum Bonsai

Root-Over-Rock Workshop Well Attended

Our February meeting had twenty people in attendance and everyone was very involved with the ROR workshop. Fifteen trees were matched to fifteen participants who each arranged their trident maple onto a rock, anchoring the roots with string, raffia or tape and then planting in a deep container to allow the roots to grow deep and thick.
